## **POSITION SUMMARY**

ACP'S / CP'S are responsible for the safe provision of Advanced Life Support ("ALS") patient care in the pre-hospital and in clinic settings. They must work in cooperation with allied emergency and health care personnel to provide the highest level of proficiency in the preservation of life and health. Working in an ALS service requires the ACP / CP to work alongside a Primary Care Paramedic (PCP") to facilitate delivery of service. This position reports directly to the Community Health Team Lead for the responsibilities listed and additional duties as required and designated.

### **Responsibilities include, but will not be limited to:**

- Administration duties
- Ensures medical equipment and medical supplies are of an adequate amount so that patient care is always optimal.
- Provides basic rescue and extrication as well as transport patients while providing the highest level of pre-hospital medical care at the level of an ACP registered car professional.
- Participates in public relation events and public education seminars when on duty as scheduled.
- Performs general cleaning and maintenance of the emergency service that are of the Public Safety Building.

### **MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:**

#### **Education and Experience:**

- High school diploma or GED is required.
- Graduate of a provincially approved ACP training program or equivalent as defined in the National Occupational Competency Profile by the Paramedic Association of Canada.

#### **Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:**

- Deliver ALS level of care in a rapid, decisive and effective manner within challenging environmental and patient care conditions; including, but not limited to, long hours with minimal sleep, strenuous physical and emotional demands, in varying environments and hours.
- The ability to direct PCPs within their scope of practice.
- Fulfill all aspects of their job description independent of direct supervision.
- Develop a high standard of interpersonal and communication skills.
- Foster cohesiveness, understanding and trust in a team environment, independent of individual personalities.
- Maintain a high level of commitment of the provision of pre-hospital care, exemplified by meeting the requirements of a rotating work schedule and the needs of a highly interdependent team.

#### **Requirements:**

- Registered in accordance with the Health Professions Act as an ACP with the Alberta College of Paramedics.
- Must maintain a clear criminal record and notify the employer of criminal charges.
- Must have and maintain a minimum Class 4 driver's licence with less than eight (8) demerit points.
- Advanced Cardiac Life Support Certification is required.
