POSITION SUMMARY

The role of the Community Health / Home Care RN is to provide Home Care Case Management and Home Care Nursing treatment. Will also provide functional supervision of support care personnel and provide professional guidance and assistance to Community Health / Home Care team in acquiring the knowledge and skills necessary to assume control and manage their Community Health Programs.

Responsibilities include, but will not be limited to:

- Receives referrals for clients across the lifespan, with varying Health care needs from institutions, community agencies and individuals. Acts as a consultant and community resource person in order to facilitate access to services for eligible clients.
- Assess the needs of the person who cannot function independently in the community and of their families, according to the Siksika Nation Home Care / Community Health Program.
- Maintain the security, confidentiality, accuracy, integrity, and legality of the patient records including the electronic database system.
- Screens referrals for eligibility and suitability for admission to home care in accordance with policy of the Siksika Nation Home Care Program.
- Records communicable disease information for submission to Regional, Federal and Provincial authorities for contact tracing, surveillance, epidemiological research and development of public health policies.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Education and Experience:

- Affiliation member in good standing with College and Association of Registered Nurses Alberta.
- Bachelor of Nursing degree is preferred.
- Experience in home care nursing / community health nursing would be an asset.
- Current cardiopulmonary resuscitation, basic rescuer level and first aid certificate to be renewed annually.
- Equivalent combination of education and experience may be considered.
