POSITION SUMMARY

Siksika Health Services (SHS) is hiring a **Registered Nurse** to join the Community Health team. The role of the Siksika Community Health Registered Nurse is to provide professional guidance and assistance to community leaders and other community health team in acquiring the knowledge and skills necessary to assume control and manage their Community Health Programs.

Responsibilities include, but will not be limited to:

- Community Health Nursing: includes health promotion, education, prevention, population health programs, environmental health and community development.
- Assesses plans and implements a comprehensive preventive community health program.
- Maintain the security, confidentiality, accuracy, integrity and legality of the patient records including the electronic database system.
- Collaborate and establish and maintain working relationships with, both internal (e.g. First nations leadership, other health care providers) and external (e.g. Provincial and Federal counterparts) health care professionals and community service providers.
- In emergency situations, may be necessary to stabilize client, provide treatment and arrange medical evacuation of seriously ill or injured patients to nearest suitable medical facility.
- Records communicable Disease information for submission to Regional, Federal and Provincial authorities for contract tracing, surveillance, epidemiological research and development of public health policies.
