POSITION SUMMARY

The Addictions Support Worker will implement the outpatient and inpatient addictions program; which includes the newly developed Integrated Mental Health and Addictions model that incorporates a model developed by the Matrix Institute. The incumbent will be responsible for developing rapport with the client and meeting the client where they are at. The Addictions Support Worker will need to provide addiction support or case management in an individual or group setting; to include the traditional session, Matrix group sessions, treatment assessment and preparation, case management, planning and implementing community programs and outreach services.

Responsibilities include, but will not be limited to:

- Collaborate with the Addictions Coordinator in the overall Mental Health and Addictions activities: traditional pathway, inpatient, outpatient and aftercare model of care.
- Ensure that clients are provided with a wide range of opportunities of service delivery and programs; in conjunction with the Treatment Plan Readiness process.
- Agree to be trained in the Matrix Model of care.
- Assist with implementing and facilitating the Outpatient Matrix Institute model of care, program instruction to be grounded in Matrix Institute on Addictions Intensive Outpatient Treatment model:
 - Matrix program is an outpatient program that is 16 weeks.
 - Weeks 1 – 4 on the individual or group working on Early Recovery Skills, Relapse Prevention and Family Education as well as 12 Step Meetings or other Spiritual Meetings.
 - Weeks 5 – 16 focus on Relapse Prevention, Family Education and Social Support.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Education and Experience:

- Bachelor / Diploma in Addictions, Social Worker or related field.
- Class 4 Drivers License is required
- The incumbent will provide Addictions support and case management for clients. This is for individual & group settings.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

- Demonstrated leadership and communication skills.
- Excellent organizational and time management skills.
- Excellent computer skills and knowledge (Word, Excel, Power Point); familiarity with using databases.
- Must be willing to work evenings and weekends
