POSITION SUMMARY

The Addictions Support Worker will implement the outpatient and inpatient addictions program, which includes the newly developed Integrated Mental Health and Addictions model that incorporates a model developed by the Matrix Institute. The incumbent will be responsible for developing rapport with the client and meeting the client where they are at. The Addictions Support Worker will need to provide addiction support or case management in an individual or group setting; to include the traditional session, Matrix group sessions, treatment assessment and preparation, case management, planning and implementing community programs.

Responsibilities include, but will not be limited to:

- Incorporate the overall Mental Health and Addictions activities: traditional pathway, inpatient, outpatient and aftercare model of care.
- Will establish rapport and provide support to client throughout the recovery process.
- Ensure that clients are provided with a wide range of opportunities of service delivery and programs, in conjunction with the Treatment Plan Readiness process.
- Develop a comprehensive client care plan, that includes the recommendations of the Intake Assessment.
- Assist with implementing and facilitating the Outpatient Matrix Institute model of care, program instruction to be grounded in Matrix Institute on Addictions Intensive Outpatient Treatment model:

Education and Experience:

- Bachelor or Diploma degree in Addictions, Social Work, Nursing, Health Management or related field.
- 2 years experience working in the field of addictions and/or addictions counseling preferred.
- Certified Addictions Counselor I and II preferred.
